Age limit

There is no age limit for the Post of Professor and Associate Professor. However for the post of Assistant Professor upper age limit shall be 35 years as on the last date of application, relaxable by 5 years in case of OBC and SC/ST category.

General Instructions for candidates for appointment by selection

1. The candidate must be a citizen of India.
2. Application forms are supplied on request to Recruitment cell of the University. The candidate can also download the application form and other related information from the University website www.upvetuniv.edu.in A candidate may request application form by sending a self addressed envelop stamped worth Rupees 35/- sized 22cm. x 15cm.

Persons already in service (Government/Quasi Government or private), permanent or temporary, must submit an advance copy of application along with the application fee direct to the Recruitment cell of the University so as to reach on or before the closing date i.e. **08-10-2010**

In no case the application received after the closing date will be considered.

3. Candidate should send only one copy of the application form addressed to the In charge Recruitment cell with the name of post and advertisement no. mentioned on the envelop. The following documents need to be attached with application form.
 - 3.1 Crossed Demand Draft of Rs. 1000/- (valid for six months, with name and address of the candidate on its back) payable to the "Finance officer Veterinary University, Mathura" at Mathura-281001 (U.P.)
 - 3.2 SC/ST candidate need to send Rs. 500/- only and must attach an attested copy of caste certificate. The caste certificate should be as per U.P. Government reservation rules in the absence of which candidates will be considered among UR category.
4. Applications not accompanied by the prescribed fee will not be considered. The fee will not be refunded under any circumstances.

5. Candidate applying from outside India should arrange to send International Crossed Demand Draft for US \$ 50 before the last date of application.
6. Original certificate of academic qualifications, certificates of experience, publications and their list, award certificates, proof of special attainments etc. may please be produced before the selection committee at the time of interview.
