

Observation of Swachhta Pakhwada during the period from 1st – 15th Nov., 2016

Swachhta Pakhwada was celebrated at UP Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Pashu Chikitsa Vigyan Vishwavidyalaya evam Go Anusandhan Sansthan, Mathura from 1st – 15th Nov., 2016 during which following activities were held:



1. Before start of this pakhwada a drawing competition was organized on topic “Clean India” on 21st Oct, 2016 in which 27 students participated.
2. Debate competition was organized on 8th Nov., 2016 on topic “Clean India: Attitude change is more important than campaign.
3. A great thrust on greening the campus has been initiated by way of planting more than 1000 plants in the campus.
4. A cleanliness drive under the auspices of Swachhta pakhwada was undertaken at TVCC on foundation day of the Kothari Veterinary Hospital on 8th November, 2016 to spread awareness about the importance and need of cleanliness among the students, faculty, staff and the animal owners. All students of BVSc & AH, teachers and staff of the clinical departments actively participated in this event and cleaned the premises and the surroundings of the Kothari Hospital as a small contribution to the ongoing *Swachchha Bharat* Campaign. Hon’ble Vice-Chancellor of the University, Prof. K.M.L. Pathak was also present to be a part of the drive and boost the morale of one and all.

5. The sanitary facilities at hostels and other places were inspected and all the sewerage disposal system was cleaned and sanitized.
6. Banners on Swachhta were displayed at important places in campus and main entrance of the University.
7. The waste materials, broken furniture, unusable equipments and other non functional materials were disposed off by write-off and subsequent auction process.
8. During the Swachhta Pakhwada the officers, faculty, staff and students cleaned their seating place and respective offices/ Departments along with its surrounding.
9. Swachh day was organized on 11th Nov., 2016 by cleaning hostels and their surrounding areas; and university campus by teachers, staff and students of University.

Hon'ble Vice-chancellor of University Prof. (Dr.) KML Pathak addressed officers, faculty, staff and students of University in which he highlighted the importance of cleanliness and sanitation and he shared his personal experience about cleanliness. Hon'ble Vice-chancellor motivated the officers, faculty, students and staff of University to keep their surroundings clean and contribute in Swachh Bharat Mission.
11. Mass Swachhta pledge was administered by Hon'ble Vice-chancellor to all the students, teachers, officers and staff of University to keep their offices/ hostels/ campus clean and green.
