From the Desk of Organizing Secretary, Dr C.M. Singh Birth Centenary Year Celebrations cum International Webinar

I would like to cordially welcome you to DUVASU, Mathura.

Uttar Pradesh Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Pashu Chikitsa Vigyan Vishwavidyalaya Evam Go-Anusandhan Sansthan (DUVASU), Mathura, first of its kind in the State and fourth in the Country, was established on 25th October 2001 with the College of Veterinary Science & AH., the erstwhile U.P. College of Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry, Mathura as its main constituent College.

“Brijbhoomi”-The land of Lord Krishna is famous since ages for its animal wealth mainly cows and the whole of *Brij Kshetra* is popular for its milk and milk products. Recognizing the importance of livestock of this area, the erstwhile U.P. College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry was established in Mathura by Govt of U.P. in 1947. It was the first Veterinary College in Asia to confer the degree in Veterinary Science. Ever since the establishment of this College, it has contributed significantly not only in terms of number of graduates and postgraduates of high scholastic order, but also quality research of national and international standards. This College has a glorious past and the distinction of having its alumni holding high positions in India and abroad as teachers, research workers, policy maker, consultants and administrators.

In the year 1975, this College was made a constituent College of the newly established C.S. Azad University of Agriculture and Technology, Kanpur. However, keeping in view the requirement of trained and competent manpower in the field of Veterinary Science, Animal Husbandry, Fisheries and other allied disciplines and also to give a fillip to research on different aspect of cattle production, Govt. of Uttar Pradesh established U.P. Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Pashu Chikitsa Vigyan Vishwavidyalaya Evam Go-Anusandhan Sansthan, Mathura, the fourth Veterinary University in the country and the Veterinary College, Mathura became the first constituent College of this University.

We, at DUVASU, Mathura feel honoured and privileged to host Dr C.M. Singh Birth Centenary Year Celebrations (30-11-2021 to 30-11-2022) cum International Webinar on "Advances of Veterinary Sciences during Platinum Jubilee Year of India's Independence (1947-2022)".

Dr C.M. Singh: A Brief Profile

"Doyen of Veterinary Profession"- Dr Chinta Mani Singh was born on 30th November, 1922 in Belaon village of Jaunpur district of Uttar Pradesh. He completed his GBVC degree from Bihar Veterinary College, Patna with gold medal in the year 1947. He started his **glorious career** from **Veterinary College, Mathura** in the year 1950. He obtained the MS and PhD from MSU, East Lansing, USA in 1954 and 1956, respectively. He worked as Post-Doctoral Fellow in Virology for one year at Cornell University, Ithaca, USA. In the year 1957, he joined UP Veterinary College, Mathura as Professor and Head, Department of Pathology and Bacteriology. He was an excellent teacher and researcher. Later, he joined as Dean at Veterinary College, Hisar and Director, Indian Veterinary Research Institute, Izatnagar, Bareilly, UP in 1966 and worked dedicatedly for the cause of Veterinary profession as a proficient administrator and distinguished educationist. A visionary with contemplative plans lead to the establishment of different divisions at IVRI and converted post-independent IVRI of 5 Divisions into 21 Divisions of National Institute of International fame. He superannuated from the post of Director, IVRI, Izatnagar in 1982. Dr C.M. Singh was elected as the Founder President of the National Academy of Veterinary Sciences (India), New Delhi and Founder President of Veterinary Council of India, New Delhi.

Dr C.M. Singh was an eminent Veterinary Pathologist and Microbiologist and made outstanding contributions in animal diseases mainly listeriosis, salmonellosis, mycoplasmosis, bovine lymphosarcoma and slow viral respiratory diseases. Due to enormous extension of research infrastructure during Five Year Plans to meet the need of farmers and industry, IVRI, Bangalore Campus was developed for Foot and Mouth Disease vaccine R&D. High Security Animal Disease Laboratory at Bhopal (now NIHSAD) was established; an institution of his visionary planning. Four research institutes namely, Central Avian Research Institute, Izatnagar and Central Institute for Research on Goats, Makhdoom, Mathura, Directorate of FMD, Bhubaneshwar and NIHSAD, Bhopal developed separately for poultry and goat production and disease diagnosis and control, respectively. His significant contributions in development of Department of Pathology and Bacteriology at Veterinary College, Mathura and IVRI as a whole is a true testimony reflecting his dynamic stewardship. IVRI is well known as Mecca for Veterinarians, owing to its uniqueness in integrating research, disease investigation, extension, technology development and teaching. Even after superannuation, he did not sit idly. He felt the need to reform the Veterinary Education in this country and was instrumental in creation of Veterinary Council of India and National Academy of Veterinary Sciences. Dr C.M. Singh had collaboration and interaction with international agencies like - FAO, WHO, UNDP, SIDA, DANIDA, etc. He attended a number of international seminars and symposia on epidemiology and zoonotic diseases in different parts of the world. He guided several eminent veterinarians for their masters and doctoral programmes in the disciplines of Pathology, Bacteriology and Virology. As a person, Dr Singh was simple, honest and hardworking with no time for personal comfort and family affairs. Therefore, some people call him “Doyen of Veterinary Profession”, others considered him as “*Bhism Pitamah*”, “*Purushottam*”, “*Karm Yogi*” and “*Prerana Shrot*”.

Dr C.M. Singh Endowment Trust was established with his directive and blessings in 1999 with objectives of advancement of veterinary science and welfare of livestock, farmers and Veterinarians of this country. Since then, Trust is working on his principles for the cause of Veterinary Profession.
