General Instructions

1. The candidate must be a citizen of India.
2. The application form and other related information can be downloaded from the University website www.upvetuniv.edu.in.
3. The University reserves the right to alter/modify any condition at any stage.
4. Merely having fulfilled the essential qualifications will not entitle a candidate to be called for interview.
5. Persons already in service (Government/Quasi Government or private, permanent or temporary), must submit an advance copy of their application along with the application processing fee direct to the **In-charge Recruitment Cell, Uttar Pradesh Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Pashu Chikitisa Vigyan Vishwavidyalaya Evam Go Anusandhan Sansthan, Mathura (U.P.)-281 001**, so as to reach on or before the closing date 23/01/2023, not later than 5:00P.M.
6. In no case the application received after the closing date and time will be considered.
7. Candidate should send only one copy of the application form addressed to the **In-charge Recruitment Cell** with the name of post and advertisement no. mentioned on the envelop.
8. The candidate is required to enclose the following documents with the application form.
 - i. A crossed Demand Draft worth ₹ 2000/- as application processing fee, drawn in favour of "Finance Officer, Veterinary University, Mathura," payable at Mathura-281001 (U.P.). The candidate should write his/her name, address and the post allied for (with category) on back of the draft.
 - ii. Candidates belonging to SC/ST categories are required to submit a crossed Demand Draft worth ₹ 1000/- only as application processing fee and must attach an attested copy of caste certificate. The caste certificate should be as per U.P. Government Reservation Rules, in the absence of which the application will be summarily rejected.
 - iii. Attested copies of certificate/degrees in support of educational qualifications.
9. The candidates are advised to fill each and every column of the application form (Part-A & B) appropriately. Incomplete applications are liable to be rejected.
10. The application processing fee will not be refunded under any circumstances.
11. Candidates applying from outside India should send Crossed International Demand Draft for US\$ 70 before the last date of application.
12. The candidates who wish to apply for more than one post, should submit separate application forms in separate envelopes accompanied by relevant enclosures and bank draft for each post. The candidate will have to indicate category of post against which he/ she wishes to apply for, along with item number (Sr. No. of post) in part A and Part B of the application form. One envelope should contain one application only.
13. The candidate should clearly note that the university will, in no case, be responsible for non-receipt of the application or any delay in receipt thereof on any account including postal delays. Applications received after the last date shall stand rejected.
14. Self-attested photocopies of the required documents must be attached with the application form without which benefit claimed for calculation of academic score will be granted. The candidates must produce the original certificate of academic qualifications, certificates of experience, publications, award certificates, proof of special attainments etc. at the time of interview.
15. Eight copies of Part-B of the application form should be attached with the application.
16. Furnishing false information or suppression of any factual information in the application would be considered a disqualification and the candidate will not be considered for employment under this university. If any such false information comes to the notice at any time during the service of the person, his services are liable to be terminated.
17. No recommendations or recommendatory letters be sent or arranged to be forwarded to the University. Canvassing in any form will disqualify a candidate.
18. The University will not pay any transit fare for appearing in the interview and for the domain knowledge test.
19. The candidate must be in sound health. He/she must be prepared to undergo such medical examination and satisfy such medical authority, as required by the University.
20. The University is governed by the Acts & Statutes as amended from time to time.
21. All communications, in respect of applications for recruitment against the posts advertised should be addressed to the **In-charge Recruitment Cell, Uttar Pradesh Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Pashu Chikitisa Vigyan Vishwavidyalaya Evam Go Anusandhan Sansthan, Mathura (U.P.)-281 001**, and should bear the following particulars;

 - b. Name of the post applied for.

22. Signatures (with date and place) of the candidate are essentially required at appropriate places in the Application Form. The University will not consider unsigned applications. The photograph should be attested.
23. The candidates called for interview may have to make a short presentation of his/her achievements, skills and abilities.
24. Salary against the pay scales will be as applicable under UGC/ICAR/State Government rules.
25. If at any stage it is discovered that the candidate used political / or any other undesirable influence or is found having submitted false certificate / degree will not only summarily be rejected but proceeded against legally.
26. Selection procedure to the post of Assistant Professor shall be completed in two steps (as per the Guidelines issued by the Governor/Chancellor's secretariat, vide no. E-5862/GS, dated 03.09.2021 and amendments thereof).
27. In the first step, candidates' basic academic performance and subject domain knowledge (Domain Knowledge test) shall be assessed. The basic academic score will carry a weightage of 100 while the domain Knowledge test will carry a weightage of 40.0. The candidates will be shortlisted and called for interview based on composite score of these two. This stage will only be qualifying in nature and will not carry any weightage for final selection of candidate.
28. In the second step, the candidates shortlisted in the first step shall be called for interview and they shall have to make a presentation and qualify the interview conducted. The selection of candidate will be solely on the basis of performance in this step.
29. Selection procedure to the post of Associate Professor and Professor shall be completed in two steps. In the first step, on the basis of information furnished by the candidate, his/ her basic academic score shall be generated and on the basis of this score the candidates will be shortlisted to be called for interview. This stage will only be qualifying in nature and will not carry any weightage for final selection of candidate.
30. In the second step the shortlisted candidates will have to appear in the interview. The selection of candidate will be solely on the basis of performance in this step.

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR TEACHING POSTS

1. Professor:

- a. A recognized Veterinary qualification included in the First and Second Schedule of Indian Veterinary Council Act; 1984 & must be registered with a State Veterinary Council/Veterinary Council of India.
- b. B.V.Sc. & A.H. with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade in the point scale.
- c. Master's degree in the concerned subject with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade in the point scale.
- d. Ph.D. in the concerned subject.
- e. A minimum of 10 years of experience of teaching / research /extension in educational or research institute, of which at least two years should be as Associate Professor or equivalent excluding the leave period for doing Ph.D.

2. Associate Professor:

- a. A recognized Veterinary qualification included of the First and Second Schedule in Indian Veterinary Council Act; 1984 & must be registered with a State Veterinary Council/Veterinary Council of India.
- b. B.V.Sc. & A.H. with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade in the point scale.
- c. Master's degree in the concerned subject with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade in the point scale.
- d. Ph.D. in the concerned subject.
- e. Eight years' Experience in relevant subject as an Assistant Professor/Scientist / Lecturer/ Extension specialist in educational or research institute excluding the leave period for doing Ph.D.

Note:

A. For the post of **Associate Professor Agriculture & Fodder Crops at Sr. No. 12** the qualification will be:

- a. B.Sc Agriculture with atleast 55% marks or its equivalent grade in the point scale.
- b. Master Degree in Agronomy or Plant Breeding with atleast 55% marks or its equivalent grade in the point scale.
- c. Ph.D in Agronomy or Plant Breeding
- d. 8 years of Teaching /Research /Extension experience in educational or research institute as Assistant Professor/Scientist/ Lecturer/ Extension specialist in educational or research institute excluding the leave period for doing Ph.D.

OR

- a. Recognized Veterinary qualification included of the First and Second Schedule in Indian Veterinary Council Act; 1984 & must be registered with a State Veterinary Council/Veterinary Council of India.
- b. B.V.Sc. & A.H. with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade in the point scale.
- c. Master degree in LPM with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade in the point scale.
- d. Ph.D. in LPM.
- e. Eight years' Experience in relevant subject as an Assistant Professor/ Scientist / Lecturer/ Extension specialist in educational or research institute excluding the leave period for doing Ph.D.

B. For the post of **Associate Professor Animal Genetics & Breeding (Livestock Economics & Statistics) at Sr. No. 14** M.V.Sc and Ph.D level qualification should be in Livestock/ Dairy Economics/Statistics/Bio-statistics.

C. For the post of **Associate Professor Veterinary Clinical Practices-Internship at Sr. No. 17** M.V.Sc and Ph.D level qualification can be in any one of the Clinical subjects i.e. Veterinary Surgery & Radiology/Veterinary Medicine/Veterinary Gynaecology & Obstetrics.

3. Assistant Professor:

- a. A recognized Veterinary Qualification included in the First and Second Schedule of Indian Veterinary Council Act; 1984 & must be registered with a State Veterinary Council/Veterinary Council of India.
- b. B.V.Sc. & A.H. with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade in the point scale.
- c. Master degree in the concerned subject with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade in the point scale.
- d. National Eligibility Test (NET) qualified.

Note: Essentiality of NET can be waived off for candidates holding PhD degree with course work in the concerned subject with two full length publications in a journal with NAAS rating not below 4, on the last date of submission of application. The candidates having a PhD degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
