Mathura can be fairly cold in January with 15 to 5° C/60 to 40° F at night and heat up to max 28 to 30° C/82 to 86° F in the day. The average would be around 23° C/73° F. HOST INSTITUTION & CONFERENCE VENUE

UP College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry Mathura, was established in the year 1947. It was the first Veterinary College in Asia to confer the degree in Veterinary Science. In the year 1975, this College was made a constituent College of the newly established C.S. Azad University of Agriculture and Technology, Kanpur. To provide impetus to the college, in all-round development in veterinary and allied sector in Braj-region, Uttar Pradesh Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Pashu Chikitsa Vigyan Vishwavidyalaya Evam Go-Anusandhan Sansthan, Mathura, was established in the year 2001 with the College of Veterinary Science & AH as its main constituent College. The University is located on the Mathura-Agra road and is about 5 km from Mathura Junction railway station and 4 km from new bus stand. The XIV Biennial National Conference of Association of Public Health Veterinarians and Symposium will be held at the College of Veterinary Science & AH, DUVASU, Mathura.

MAJOR THEME

India's economy is one of the fastest growing economies in the world. However, this remarkable economic development has also changed the socioeconomic dynamics of the country, posing several challenges in public health context. The human and animal health intertwined with environmental issues make the challenges big and complex. Hence, tackling such multifactorial, multipronged, problems, interdisciplinary approach needs to be adopted by health organizations and policy makers. The theme of the conference is chosen to recognize and address these challenges and to formulate strategic directives in an attempt to inform health policy and expand scientific knowledge.

SCIENTIFIC PROGRAM

It will involve six technical sessions besides one plenary session and one poster session.

Session I: Interdisciplinary approach to Public Health: (Clinical challenges associated with emerging infections, Preparedness of the Clinical Microbiology Laboratory for Emerging Infections, New Developments in Vaccines, Outbreak Preparedness - Surveillance, Policy and Communication, Public awareness, Biotechnology interventions in diagnostics and vaccinology).

Session II: Food quality and food safety of animal origin: (Foodborne pathogens, Foodborne disease, Food contamination, Microbiological and chemical aspects of food safety, Food safety management, Food packaging).

Session III: Viral, bacterial, fungal and parasitic zoonosis and vector born disease: (Investigation, Sero-monitoring, Pathogenesis, Immunology of emerging vector-borne and zoonotic diseases).

Session IV: Global health at the human-animal-ecosystem interface: (Global Public Health challenges, Global perspectives on one Health, Public Health diplomacy, Global preparedness for public health emergencies, healthcare-associated infections, Global warming and climate change, Pollution, Transboundary animal and human diseases).

Session V: Emerging zoonotic diseases, Neglected emerging diseases and Antibiotic resistance: (Surveillance, early detection and outbreak response, genomic and molecular epidemiology, Monitoring of emerging zoonosis and AMR in India, Development and validation of assay for diagnosis of ESD).

Session VI: Animal Healthcare and Veterinary Phytotherapy: (Ethno-veterinary medicine, science and practice of veterinary phytotherapy and alternate medicine, clinical, in vivo and in vitro research with medicinal plants or natural products for animals).

CALL FOR PAPERS / ABSTRACTS

Original research papers, concept papers/abstracts covering one or more of the above themes are invited for presentation. Please download the abstract template from <http://www.aphv.org.in/> and follow the format carefully. Extended abstracts with title, author(s) name, affiliation, e-mail and contact number of corresponding author, session (not exceeding 350 words) in MS word, Times New Roman (Font size 12; 1.5 space) can be mailed to aphvconf2020@gmail.com before December 20, 2019. Name of presenting author should be underlined. Only quality papers will be selected for presentations in the relevant technical sessions. Submitted abstracts will be evaluated by a scientific committee and decision regarding acceptance/rejection will be communicated to the corresponding authors. **Abstract will be accepted only on receipt of registration fee of at least one of the authors.** Poster size for poster presentation should be 150 cm height and 90 cm width. The presentations/ posters will be evaluated by a jury of eminent scientists in each session. Best presentation/ poster will be awarded in the valedictory function of conference.
