College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry, Mathura, one of the premier Veterinary Colleges in the country, was established in 1947. It was the first Veterinary College in the country to start MVSc degree programmes in 1951. PhD degree programme was started in this College in 1953.

#### **ABOUT NADS (INDIA)**
