IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

1. The candidates are required to download and carefully read the Instructions for exam and Advisory for COVID-19 given with the Admit Card and strictly adhere to them.
2. All pages of the admit card are to be downloaded as they contain “Important instructions for candidates” and “Advisory for candidates regarding COVID-19” in addition to the examination centre details and Self Declaration (Undertaking) form regarding COVID-19.
3. As a precautionary measure, the candidates must reach centre as indicated against Reporting/Entry time at centre.
4. The candidates shall not be permitted to enter after the Gate Closing Time.
5. The candidates shall not be permitted to leave the Examination Room/ Hall before the end of the examination.
6. The Candidates are required to wait for instructions from Invigilator and shall not leave their seat until instructed to do so at the time of completion of the test.
7. Once instructions are given the candidates shall move out one by one in an orderly manner.
8. Candidates are suggested to visit the examination venue, a day in advance to see the arrangements at the centre, so that they do not face any problem on the day of examination.
9. The candidate shall not be allowed to enter the examination centre, without admit card and a valid ID Proof.
10. The candidates should carry only the following items with them into the examination venue:
 - a) **Admit Card along with Self Declaration (Undertaking) downloaded from the university website (a clear printout on A4 size paper) duly filled in.**
 - b) **A valid Photo identity proof**
 - c) **A transparent ball point pen**
 - d) **Additional photograph, to be pasted at the time of verification in the examination hall/room,**
 - e) **Personal hand sanitizer (50 ml)**
 - f) **Personal transparent water bottle**
11. The candidates are required to fill the required details in the Undertaking in legible handwriting, and paste the Photograph at the appropriate place before reaching the examination centre. The admit card should be duly signed by one of their parents before reaching the examination centre. They should ensure that their thumb impression (left for male candidates and right thumb for female candidates) is clear and not smudged.
12. The candidate must carry a valid photo identification proof issued by the government (PAN card/Driving License/Voter ID/Passport/Aadhaar Card (With photograph)/ E-Aadhaar/Aadhaar Enrolment No. with Photo, in original (no photocopies)
13. The candidates are NOT allowed to carry any personal belongings including electronic devices, mobile phone and other prohibited items listed in the prospectus/information bulletin to the Examination Centre. Examination Officials will not be responsible for safe keep of personal belongings and there will be no such facility.
14. Duly filled Admit Card at the end of examination must be submitted to the invigilator(s) as per instructions. Failure to do so may result in non-evaluation of your answers.
15. On completion of the test, the OMR Sheets shall be collected by the invigilator(s), till that time the candidates are required to remain in their seats.
16. Use of any unfair means or indulging in any unfair examination practices shall lead do disqualification and legal action may be initiated against the erring candidate.
17. Candidates are advised to check updates on the university website, their E-mail registered at the time of application and messages in their registered mobile no. regularly updates and information.
18. If at any stage, it is found that the candidate has submitted multiple applications, the candidature will be cancelled and legal action will be taken including debarring in all future university examinations.

ADVISORY FOR CANDIDATES REGARDING COVID-19

The university will implement Social Distancing measures as per Government of India guidelines to ensure health & safety of the candidates. Adequate measures are implemented for safety of all without compromising the high standards, sanctity, and fairness in conduct of the examination. Candidates are also required to adhere to guidelines and new process for social distancing and hygiene to ensure their own safety and health of and that of fellow candidates.

Preparation at centre

1. Standard Operating Procedures for implementing safety precautions and for maintaining required standard of hygiene will be implemented at the examination centre.
2. After making necessary arrangements for the conduct of the Pre Veterinary Test, the examination centre will be disinfected with spray sanitizer and other necessary means.
3. Seating arrangement for the candidates shall be as per the social distancing norms dictated in the GOI guidelines.
4. Hand Sanitizer will be available at the entry and inside the exam venue at various places for use by the candidates and the centre staff.
5. Thermo guns will be available at the entry point, to check the body temperature of candidates.
6. It will be ensured that all the processes are touch free to ensure social distancing norms.
7. The candidates shall reach the centre as per the reporting/entry time at the centre given in their admit card, to avoid any crowding and to maintain social distancing at the centre.

Pre-Exam Preparation

1. The candidates are required to check the respective reporting/entry time at centre given in the admit card and should strictly adhere to it to avoid any crowding and to maintain social distancing at the centre at the time of entry.
2. The candidate should ensure that their admit card is complete in all respects and details are filled in, as per instructions.
3. The candidates will be permitted to carry only certain items with them into the venue. Please refer to point-10 of 'Important Instruction for Candidates' on Page 2 for the details.

At the time of Entry

1. The candidates are required to maintain a space of at least 6 feet from each other at all the time. Queue manager/ropes and floor marks will be arranged outside the centre, please follow the instructions provided by centre staff.
2. Room/hall number will be displayed at several places at the examination centre to avoid any crowding at any one place in any situation.
3. Candidates will be required to sanitize hands by washing with soap and with a hand sanitizer before entry in centre. Hand sanitizer will be available at various locations in the centre.
4. Candidates would display their documents for verification from a safe distance.
5. Do not bring prohibited items to exam centre as there are no arrangements available for safe keeping your belongings. Please refer Point-10 of 'Important Instruction for Candidates' on Page-2 for permitted items.
6. At the time of entry, the filled in 'Undertaking' on Admit Card, and body temperature (using thermo Guns) will be checked by the centre staff. The candidates are required to strictly adhere to instructions provided by the centre staff.
7. If body temperature is higher than COVID-19 norms, candidate would be asked to be seated in a separate room or isolation Room to take the exam.
8. If a candidate violates the covid-19 directives/advisories of Government (Central/State) applicable on the day of exam and instructions mentioned in the Admit Card, he/she shall not be permitted to take the examination.

During Examination

1. Candidates are required to sign the attendance sheet
2. The candidates can sanitize their hands with sanitizer available in the examination room/hall.

After Examination

1. On completion of exam, the candidates will be permitted to move out in an orderly manner one candidate at a time. Please wait for instructions from invigilator and do not get up from your seat until advised.
2. Duly filled Admit Card at the end of examination must be handed over to the Invigilator. Failure to do so may result in non-evaluation of your OMR answer sheet.
