DUVASU - The Host University

Uttar Pradesh Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Pashu Chikitsa Vigyan Vishwavidyalaya Evam Go-Anusandhan Sansthan (DUVASU), Mathura was established by Government of Uttar Pradesh through the Act No. 27 of 2001 on October 25, 2001, by carving out all the units of College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry from C.S. Azad University of Agriculture & Technology, Kanpur. The College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry, Mathura became its first constituent college. The parent institution of this University had the distinction of being the first Veterinary College set up in independent India. It was the first Veterinary College in Asia to start degree program in Veterinary Science in 1947, M.V.Sc/M.Sc degree programs in various disciplines of Veterinary and Animal Sciences in 1951 and Ph.D. degree programs in 1953. The main campus appears impressive with the buildings of College of Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry, College of Biotechnology, College of Fisheries Science, Institute of Para - Veterinary Sciences and NAHEP building being center of attraction. The University has an excellent infrastructure and laboratory facilities for undergraduate and post graduate teaching and research.

MATHURA - The Host City

Mathura, the birth place of lord Krishna, is one of the most ancient places of India and situated on the right bank of river Yamuna at a distance of about 145 Km Southeast of Delhi and 58 Km to the north-west of Agra. It is very well connected by road, railways and air. There are direct trains from almost all major towns of the country. Nearest airport is Agra, however, the air connectivity with New Delhi is good. Mathura occupies a venerable place in the cultural history of India and the city has repeatedly witnessed the dual of construction and destruction. Twin-towns of Mathura and Vrindavan are the attraction of Hindu pilgrimage for centuries. Visit to Mathura leaves subtle and celestial effect over the minds and heart of people. Government Museum, Mathura is renowned for the art treasures of Kushana and Gupta period i.e. from 1st century A.D. The Buddha statues have been carved with much grace and delicacy. The statue, in which Buddha is seated cross legged in attitude of protection, is one of the most prestigious and famous sculptures. Mathura is not only the place of Hindu pilgrimage and a lot of foreigners throng here who are the followers of Lord Krishna. In addition, Agra (Taj Mahal), Fatehpursikri (Buland Darwaja) and Bharatpur (Keoladeo Bird Century) are the other places of tourists’ attraction.

About ISBD

Indian Society for Buffalo Development is a registered society (since 1987) at Hisar with the objective of advancement of all aspects of buffalo production. This society provides opportunities for the dissemination and exchange of knowledge and ideas through the periodic organization of scientific meetings and deliberations. It also promotes and participates in the development of buffalo production in association with organizations, national or international, having similar aims and objectives.

Weather, Accommodation & Transportation

The climate of Mathura during the month of October would be pleasant and the temperature remains between 18-30°C. The delegates would be provided accommodation on first come- first serve basis in the University campus or nearby hotels. Delegates are requested to convey details of their travel program and accompanying persons for providing accommodation during the conference before September 30, 2023 positively. Nearby Hotels may be reserved on prior request before September 30, 2023 on payment basis with the tariff ranging from Rs. 1000-2500 per day/person. Lodging charges have to be borne by the participants. Local transport would be provided by the Organizing Committee.

Symposium Program

The conference will be held for two days and will comprise of lead papers, poster presentations and scientists-industry-policy makers interface covering recent aspects of buffalo research to envision that all the challenges and problems relevant to the theme will find a solution through the exchange of experiences and scientific knowledge.

Awards: Best papers will be awarded (separate awards for students and faculty) in both oral and poster presentation categories for each session.
