Theme of the Conference

The gut microbiota is always influenced by a number of factors such as food, environment, diseases-health status and many other genetic factors. There are also wide variation in the diversity and quantity of microbes in different sections of GIT due to genetic predisposition, alimentation triggers, and environmental factors. Recently, faecal microbe transplantation has been focused as an important area of research in improving the gut health. The gastro-intestinal microbiota and their genetic products also play the important role in the development of the body immune system, host defense, energy metabolism, and nutrition of especially in GI trouble population. The recent findings on the role of gut microbiota in oncogenetic development and on the response to chemotherapy in various types of cancer are new becoming the emerging research areas. Additionally, the findings on impact of gut microbiota in developing liver diseases such as fatty liver disease, cirrhosis, and even implications in hepatocarcinoma is worth to mention. In present scenario, the role of friendly microbes and their by-products on health of human and animals need wider discussion and compilation. As such the theme of present conference will focus on the microbial transplantation and its health effect as Biotherapeutics. Further, the use of beneficial microbes is various domain of veterinary, agriculture and food industry will be discussed.

Call for Abstracts

The abstract should not exceed 800 words limit (excluding the title, authors, affiliation etc) and should be written only in the structured format with the following sections; Title, Authors and affiliations, Statement of the Problem, Methods, Results & Discussion, Conclusion & Way forward. The presenting author should be first author and underlined. Abstract papers should be typed in MS word, Times New Roman and font size 12.

1. Best Poster Presentation:

2. Young Investigator Award:

PAi conferences will also reward the Young Investigator Award for Young Scientists including Master, PhD, postdoctoral and faculty members. Young investigators should be a member of PAi and below the age of 35 years will be considered for this award.

The Abstract should be structural with title, author, affiliation; Problem statement/Introduction, methodology, result and discussion and conclusion/ way forward. The topic of the Abstract should be in any field of probiotics not necessarily in microbial transplantation with a word count of about 800 words. Last date of abstract submission: 25th November, 2024 .

The selected applicants will be required to make an oral presentation of a maximum of 8 min during the YSA session in the conference. Only 10 best abstract will be selected for oral presentation in Young Investigator Award. Rest of them will be given opportunity to present their finding in poster presentation.
