The training was financially supported by the SCSP plan of the ICAR All India Network Program on Ethno-

Veterinary Medicine. The aim of the program was to enhance the practical knowledge and skills of the 15 participating students of SC community by imparting 16 theory and 14 practical lectureson various advanced techniques viz. UV-VIS spectroscopy, qPCR, Western Blot, flow cytometry, etc. Participants also explored alternative animal models for phytoconstituent studies.
